# 1 Introducing Kerio WinRoute Firewall Software Appliance

- *Kerio WinRoute Firewall Software Appliance* is distributed in the form of a bootable ISO image file. The ISO image may be burned to a writable CD or mounted to a virtual machine.
  - The installer installs both *Kerio WinRoute Firewall* and the operating system. No operating system is required to be on the target computer prior to the installation.
  - *Kerio WinRoute Firewall Software Appliance* does not support to be installed along with another operating system on the same computer (for multiple boot).
- Kerio WinRoute Firewall VMware Virtual Appliance is also available.
- The *Software Appliance / VMware Virtual Appliance* edition has the same capabilities as the *Windows* version except that it currently does not provide the *Kerio Clientless SSL-VPN* functionality.
- All the other features including *Kerio Web Filter*, built-in anti-virus, *Traffic Policy*, *Bandwidth Limiter*, *Load Balancing*, and *Kerio StaR* are supported.

# 2 Changes in Kerio WinRoute Firewall 6.7.1 (since 6.7.0)

### **Active Directory Domain Integration**

The *Active Directory* integration options in *Administration Console* were redesigned to support the different needs the *Software Appliance / VMware Virtual Appliance* edition has in this matter. This edition of *Kerio WinRoute Firewall* allows the domain administrator to join the host computer to the domain right in the *Kerio Administration Console*.

### Support for Microsoft Windows 7

Kerio WinRoute Firewall now fully supports being run on Microsoft Windows 7.

# Workaround added for devices with broken PPTP support

Some small routers, typically ADSL modems, have a broken implementation of the PPTP protocol which causes connections to fail. The workaround assures that a PPTP connection is negotiated through *Kerio WinRoute Firewall* even if such device is in the way.

# 3 Changes in system requirements

• The required hard drive space for *Software Appliance / VMware Appliance* is 3 GB now.

### 4 Known Issues

• When trying to connect to *Kerio WinRoute Firewall 6.7.1* with an older *Administration Console*, the error message may incorrectly state that *Administration Console* version *6.8* is required (instead of *6.7.1*).
